because I started my Modeling career at the same time as Covid so its been difficult to get certain jobs. I know things are only going to get better from here!





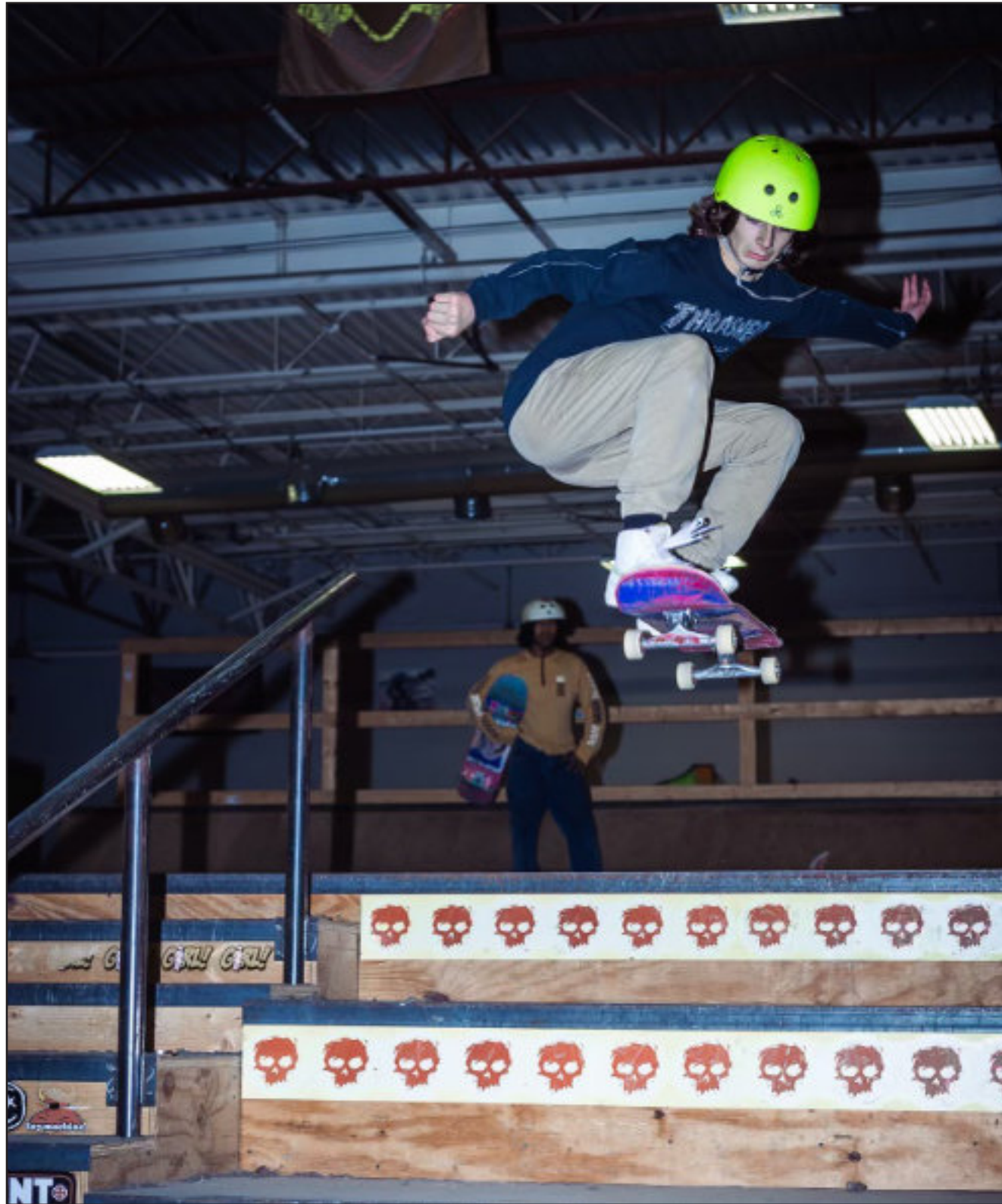

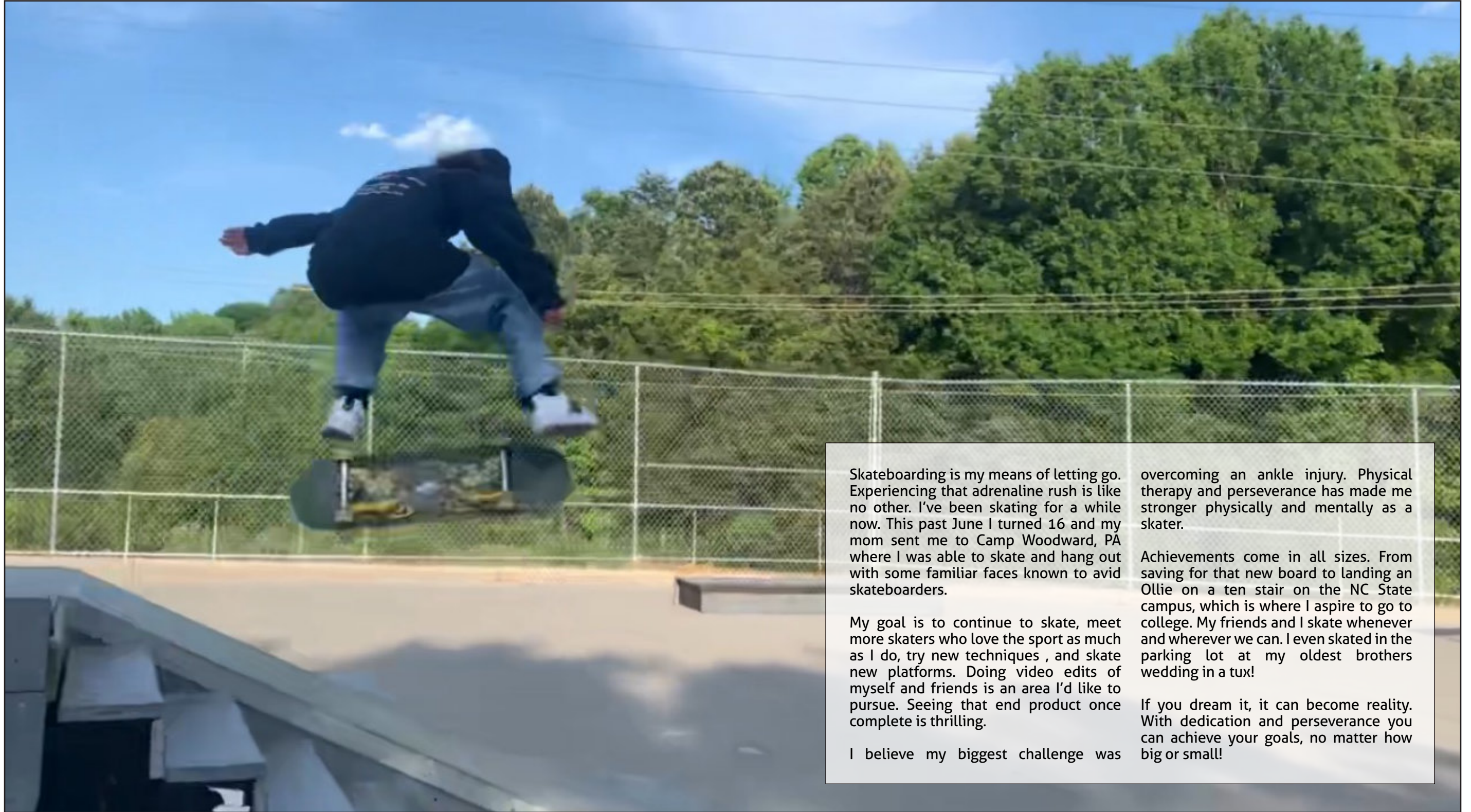
