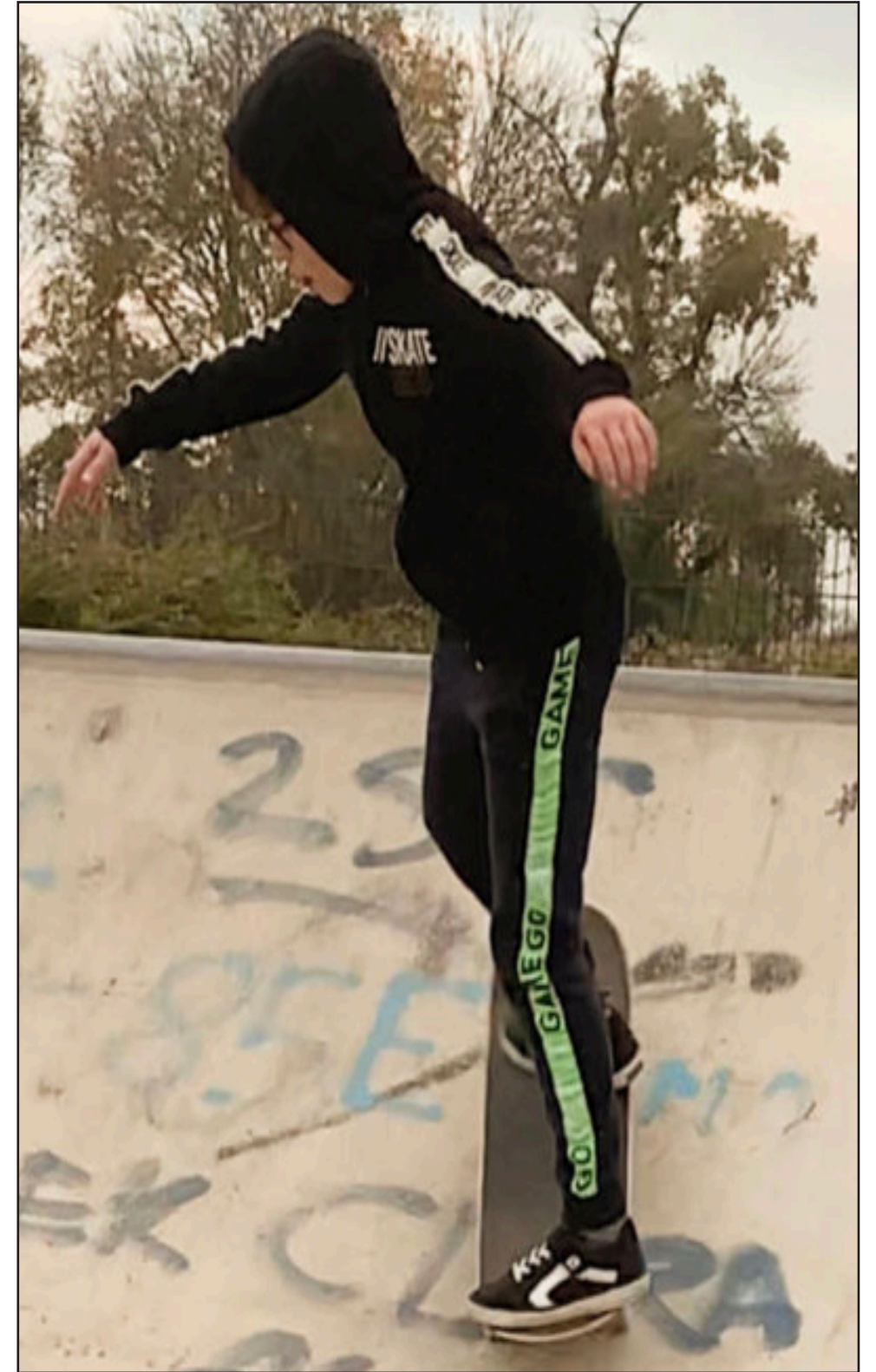
at the moment is jump off ledges. I'm really excited to keep skating and also really excited to try out roller skates, they look so fun too!

My challenge is to start and improve a few tricks... OLLIE, 50-50....!

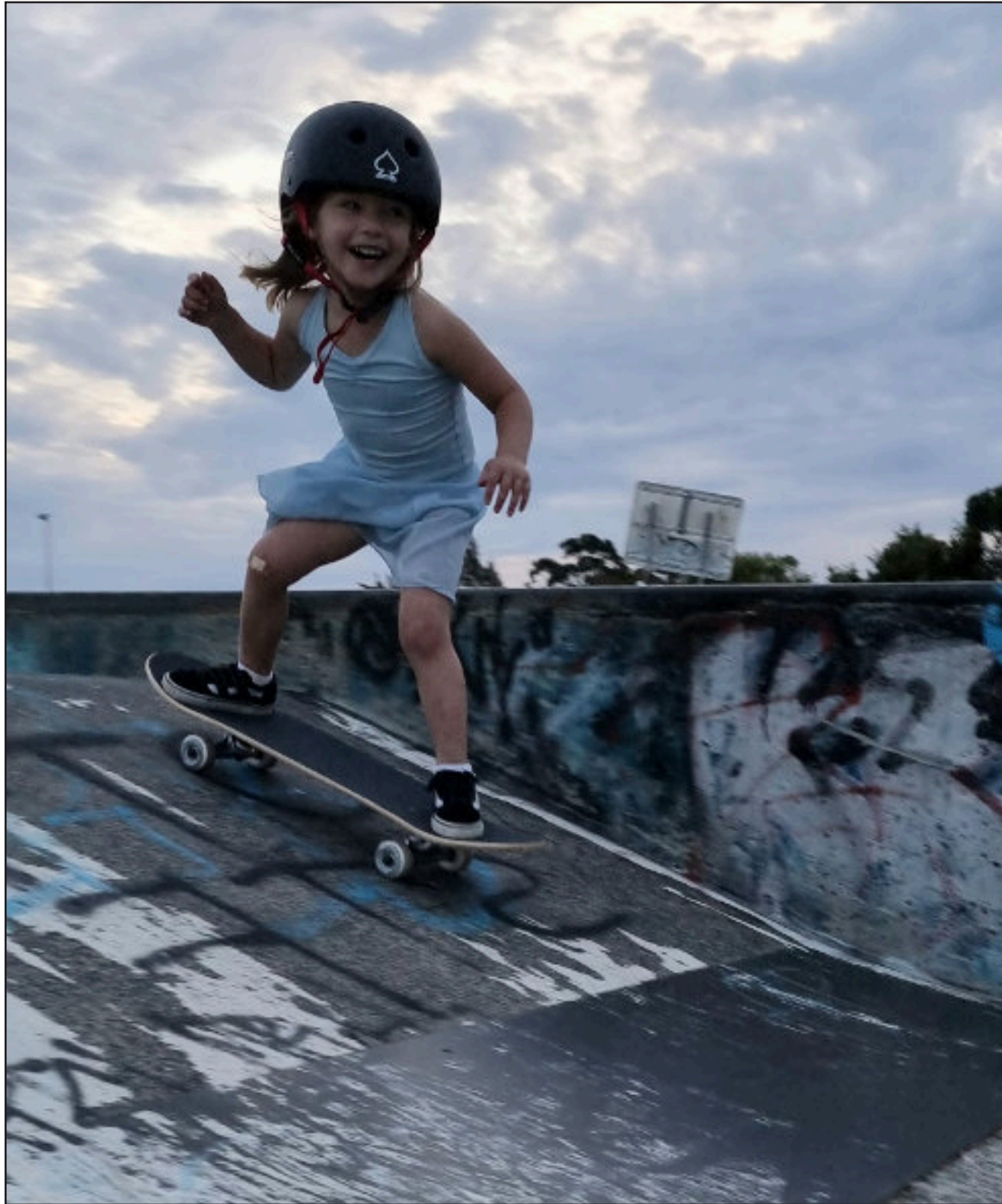
My goal is to do the tricks as well as possible and manage my board well.

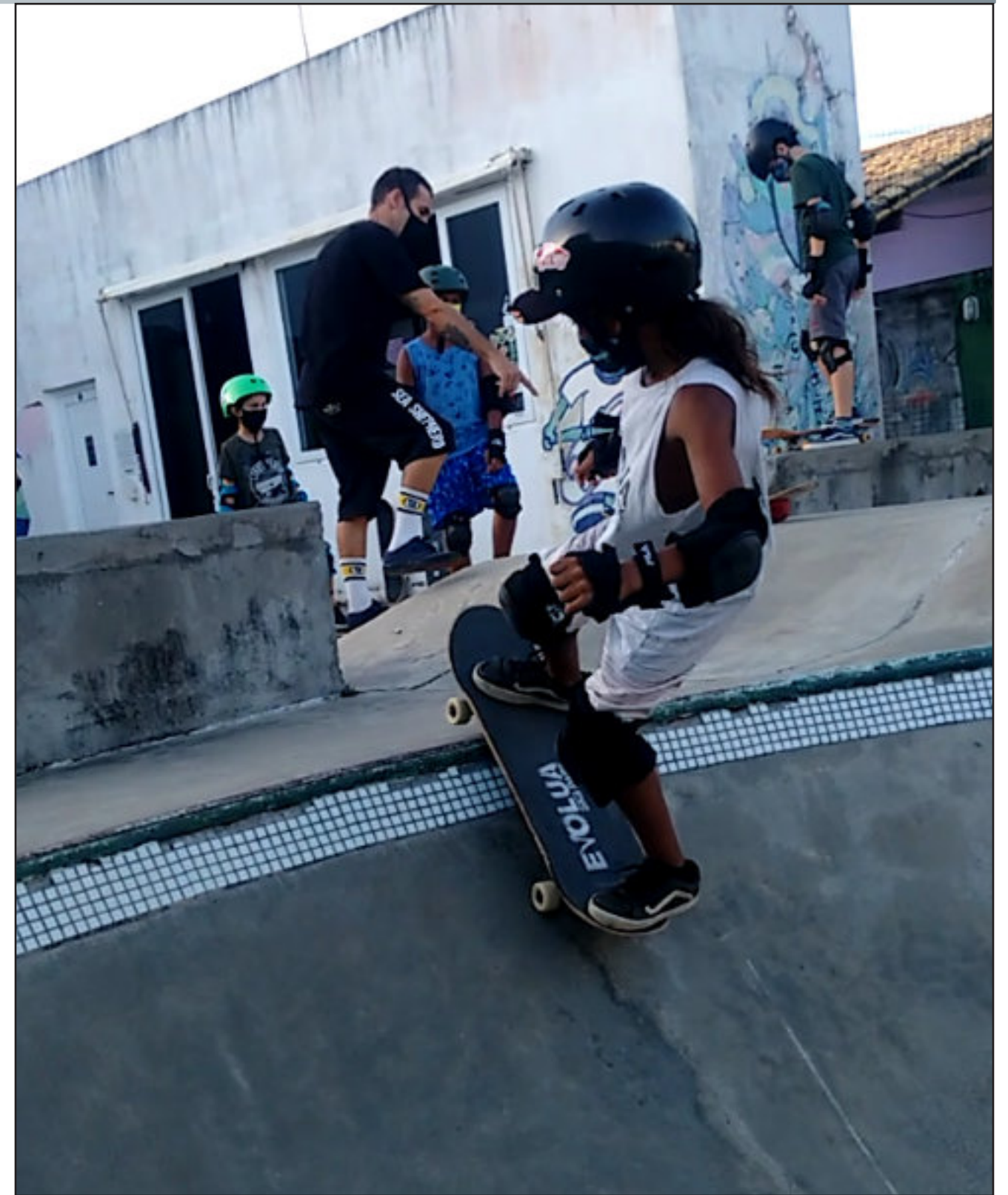

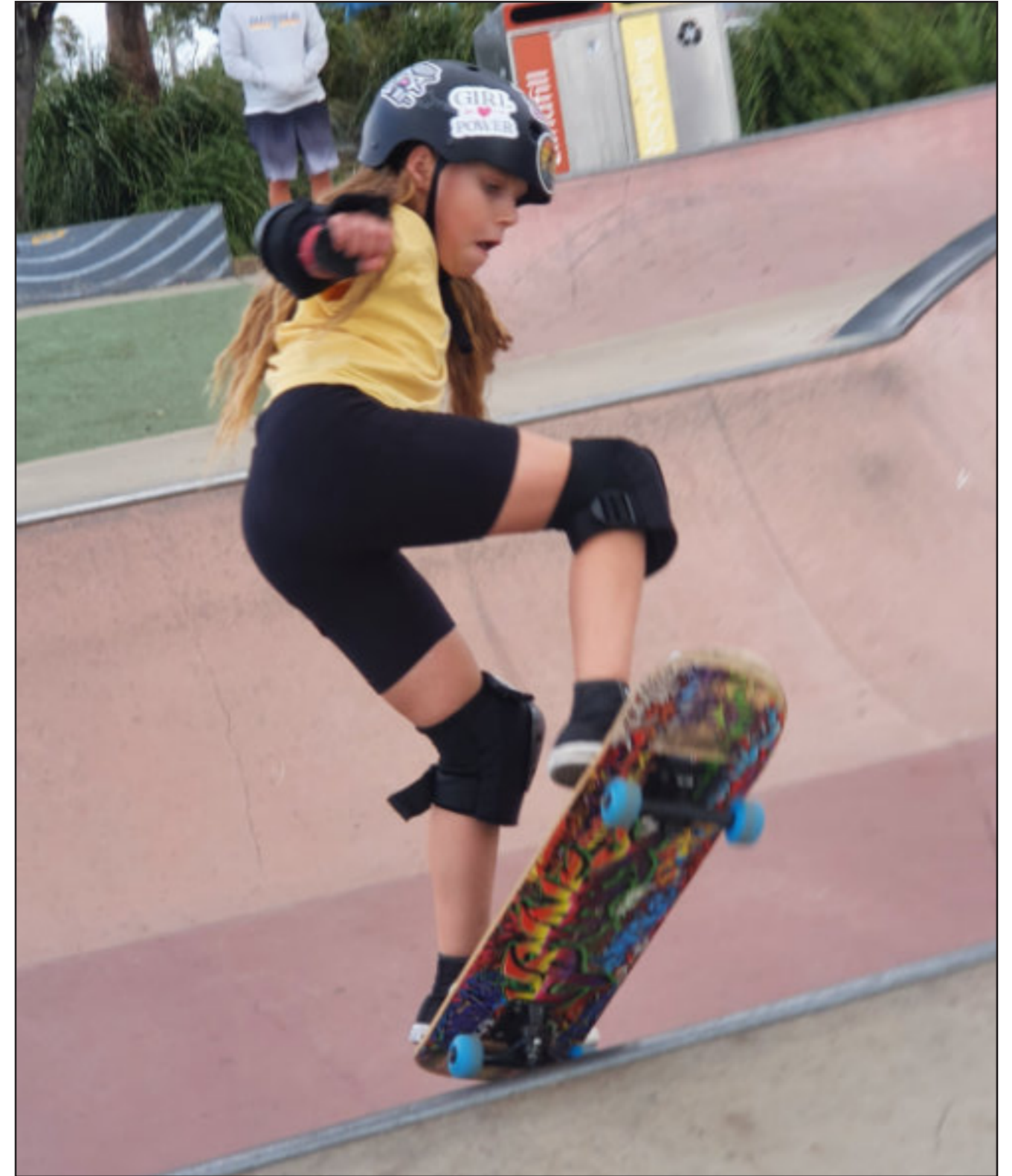
